Craft Activity

Make a moving sculpture like Andrew Carson's *Glassinator* with a paper plate, tissue paper, glue, and string!

What you will need:



Paper plate



Scissors



Glue



String



Tissue paper



Markers, crayons, or colored pencils

Title: *Glassinator*

Date Made: 2011

Materials: Blown and hot-worked glass, aluminum, and steel.

Instructions:

1) Cut out the spiral drawn on the paper plate with scissors.



2) Decorate your *Glassinator*. Color the plate with markers or crayons, and glue on crumpled up balls of tissue paper. (Tip: Try crumpling up more than one color of tissue paper together.)



3) Stick one end of the string through the hole in the center and tie a knot on the bottom side so it doesn't pull out. (This step can be tricky, so you may need to ask an adult for help. Tip: Use the tip of a pencil to push the string through the hole.)



4) Pick up your *Glassinator* by the string to see the result!
